

How to Order

For combines and grain carts, usually all the information that is needed is the year, brand, model number, and type of auger you want to cover. (Example: 1992 John Deere 9600 tank fill auger). If the auger has ever been re-flighted or if it is an auger size we don't have on file, the following information will be needed:

1 Flight Height

Reference picture A

NOTE: Flight height x 2 + center tube diameter = flighting diameter

2 Outside Diameter of Center Tube

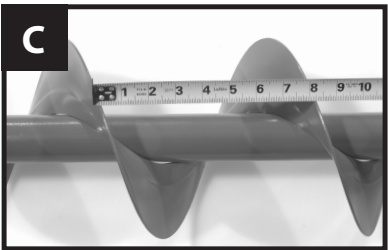
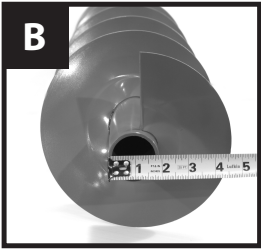
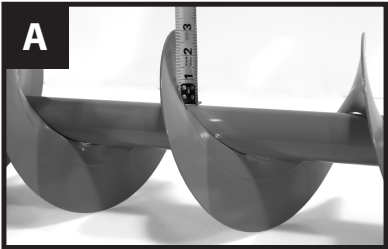
3 Pitch (space between flights)

Reference picture C

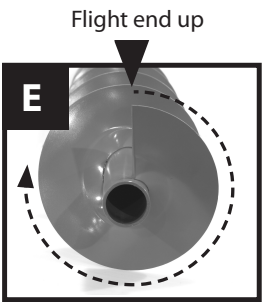
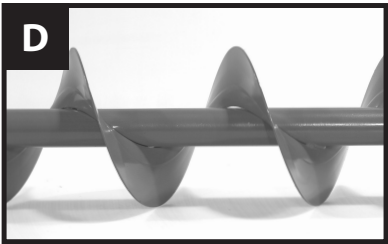
NOTE: When measuring pitch, be sure to keep the tape measure parallel with the center tube.

4 Right Hand or Left Hand

Reference pictures D and E show right hand flighting, pictures F and G show left hand flighting.
